Kingfisher class Spring

This overview outlines the topics we will Term 2 2024 be covering in each subject during the second part of Spring term.



Maths

We will continue to work from White Rose, still focusing on fractions to begin with, before moving on to mass and capacity.

English

We will begin the half term by focusing on diary writing, based on what we learned last half term about World War 1. We will then study the book 'The Lion and the Unicorn' by Shirley Hughes, where we will be creating non-chronological reports about evacuees in the style of an information poster. On Mondays, we will continue with our SPaG lessons.

Art and D&T

This half term, we will be learning D&T. We will be focusing on seasonal eating, working towards creating our own vegetable tarts using seasonal ingredients.

Science

In science, we will continue to learn about plants, specifically the parts of flowers responsible for reproduction. We will learn about how flowers are pollinated and how seeds are dispersed.

History & Geography

We will be studying geography in this half term. We will be learning about local farming and food knowledge, including where our food comes from, food miles, different types of farms and the types of foods that Norfolk is famous for farming.

PSHE

We will be looking at rights and respect in PSHE, including facts and opinions, volunteers, income, jobs and the environment.

This half term, we will be learning about Christianity, working towards answering the question 'What is good about Good Friday?'

Handwriting, Spelling and Guided Reading

We will be working on handwriting once a week. On Mondays during SPaG lessons, we will learn our new spelling rule for the week, ready for practice at home. We will then have a short spelling test the following Monday. Most children will have guided reading every day following the same pattern as previously, whilst some of the class recap phonics. On Tuesdays, the class will go to the library with Mrs Cargill.

PE will be taught by Miss Moore on Thursday mornings and Premier Sports on Tuesday afternoons. The children will be focusing on athletics with Miss Moore.

Computing

On Mondays, the children will learn computing. The children will be learning about branching databases.

Music

Mrs Cargill will be teaching us music, where we will learn about ballads.
