English

Our English will be based around Skellig by David Almond. We will focus on fiction writing: suspense and a new chapter.

We will continue to use semicolons and colons. We will focus on description and writing for an audience.

Maths

Throughout this half term, we will cover fractions, decimals and percentages, area perimeter and volume and statistics.

Science

Our science topic this half term is classification.

We follow the SCARF scheme and the theme for this term is Rights and Responsibilities.

Computing

We will be covering Data and information - An Introduction to Spreadsheets.
