Activities in red are essential and <u>must</u> be completed.

Read a book about farming or food (recorded in reading record).	Draw and decorate your own pizza fractions to show halves, thirds, quarters and fifths.	Science: draw a botanical sketch of a flower from your garden or out and about, and label the style, stigma and stamens.	Geography: go for a walk around your local area to see if you can find an arable farm, a pastoral farm and a mixed farm.
Read a library book (recorded in reading record).	Measure the mass of some items around your house. What is the heaviest thing you can find? What is the lightest thing you can find?	DT: create a seasonal salad.	PE: work on your throwing technique. How far can you throw a ball? What can you do to help you throw further?
Share a book with an adult, taking it in turns to read (recorded in reading record).	Spend 20 minutes jamming on Times Tables Rockstars.	Computing: write 10 yes/no questions about your school day for your parents to ask you.	PSHE: ask the people in your family what jobs they do. How many different jobs can you find out about?
Read to an adult who is not your parent. (recorded in reading record).	Challenge Miss Moore on Times Tables Rockstars.	English: create your own ideas for each of our SHAMPOO imagery techniques (similes, hyperboles, alliteration, metaphors, personification, onomatopoeias and oxymorons).	Easter: write about what you did over the Easter weekend.
Read your favourite book (recorded in reading record).	Complete the division challenge given to you by Miss Moore.	RE: our last big question for RE was 'Has Christmas lost its true meaning?' Do you think Easter has too? Write about what you do at Easter compared to what a Christian might do.	Music: write your own ballad!
